Respected brother/sister,

As you would be aware that Nishkam has been working since last 24 years only for social profit without any distinctions and one of its projects has been to provide assistance to poor/needy patients to enable them to undergo costly treatment/surgery. The process started with the case of Sh. Om Parkash Soni of Bhiwani (Haryana) in 1992 and with His blessings has continued uninterrupted. Nishkam was earlier mobilizing funds and providing assistance but about two years back a Medical Reserve Fund of Rs. 5 lakhs was set up so that, in emergent cases, assistance could be provided without any delay.

2. Nishkam had issued last appeal in June, 2008 and during 2008-09 so far an assistance of Rs. 4.54 lakhs has been provided to needy families out of the Medical Fund. Major cases in which assistance of more than Rs. 50000/- was provided are as under: -

1. **S. Gurjeet Singh, Tilak Vihar(New Delhi) – Rs. 0.81 lakhs**
2. **Master Gurdeep Singh, Tilak Vihar (New Delhi) – Rs. 0.51 lakhs**
3. **S. Balwant Singh, Baba Bakala (Punjab) – Rs.0.65 lakhs**
4. **Bibi Tanveer Kaur, Chaukhandi, (New Delhi) – Rs. 0.60 lakhs**
5. **Other cases (Less than Rs. 50000/-) – Rs. 1.97 lakhs**

3. As per the policy, Nishkam directly places funds at the disposal of the hospitals and the patients get the required treatment/surgery.

4. Now we have received the case of Master Aditya Pandey, aged 5 Yrs., who is having a hole in his heart and needs to undergo surgery urgently at AIIMS, New Delhi. The estimated cost of surgery is Rs. 1.40 lacs. Aditya's father is a labourer in Bhagirath Place, Chandni Chowk, Delhi. As per verification report of the sewadars of Nishkam, he earns from Rs. 3000/- to Rs. 4000/- per month. He has agreed to arrange a sum of Rs. 40,000/- and balance Rs. 1 lac is being deposited by Nishkam.

5. We appeal to all of you for generous contributions for this noble cause in order to save the life of this little boy. Kindly send your cheques/draft in favour of "**Nishkam Sikh Welfare Council (Regd.) – Medical A/c**" to the Tilak Vihar address of the Council as printed above. Also please tell your near and dear ones to contribute for this noble cause. We are sure that you will oblige us.

6. The contributions will be eligible for exemption under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
