Saundarya-an 18-month-old-baby girl, got a new lease of life. She underwent a treatment of **Jaundice** in SDM Hospital-Hubli, Karnataka. She has been suffering from such serious condition since four weeks ago and has been shifted to three hospitals. It was a difficult case and lot of money was required. There was a financial constraint in the family. A public appeal was made and Nishkam paid Rs. 20000/- to the hospital. After successful treatment, the family feels grateful to donors and all those who wished for her good health to save the life of such innocent child.



Foundation Stone of 6 houses was laid in Tarn Taran (Punjab)

A Conference Hall with new furniture and very attractive curtains have been provided. Besides our Tuition Center has also been refurnished with new desks and other equipment.

Scholarships' test was conducted for needy school-goers



The annual examination was held across 2 centers (Sukho Khalsa Sr Sec School-Tilak Nagar & Bhai Joga Singh Khalsa Girls Sr Sec School in East Patel Nagar in New Delhi) and at SGNP Girls Sr. Sec. School, Shahbad- Haryana in Nov-Dec, 2017. A total of 589 candidates were eligible to take the examination out of which 517 got appeared in the exam. People have shown big interest and like every year the number of candidates are increasing which is a remarkable gesture that our mission is giving hopes and smiles to many in need. Meritorious students (Class 7th to 12th) from underprivileged families are eligible for the test. Scholarships worth Rs. 1,549,200/- were distributed among 432 students for 2016-17 session.

SHDF raises ₹1.3 crore for underprivileged students



Just recently, our associate partner Sikh Human Development Foundation in Washington (SHDF) has raised \$210,000 or Rs 1.35 crore for underprivileged youth pursuing higher education in Punjab and neighboring areas. The fund was raised at an event featuring actor Gurpreet Singh Ghuggi. Nishkam the associate partner of SHDF has been imparting, organizing and promoting the scholarships since 2000 in India. The project was started with merely 22 scholarships and in the span of 17 years; it has crossed more than 550 scholarships mark.
