Building Hopes through Scholarships

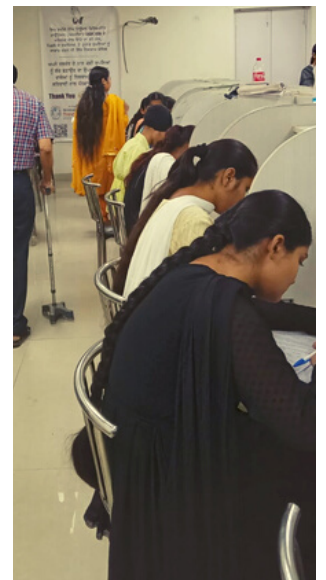
Scholarship Test for University Students

Nishkam conducted the annual college-level scholarship written test for 2023-24, simultaneously in Delhi and Punjab on the 22nd and 29th of October.

More than 3700 applicants applied for the scholarship out of which the majority of applicants are female students.

After the declaration of the test scores, the successful applicants will be interviewed later. Similarly, the renewal scholars also appeared for their interviews.

The scholarship program is funded by the Sikh Human Development Foundation, USA and is managed by Nishkam for the professional courses. Nishkam's Merit cum Means Scholarship is providing scholarships with the help of global and local donors for professional and non-professional students from underprivileged families.

Seeds distributed among the impoverished farmers of the flood-affected areas across Punjab

In Ferozepur, Nishkam distributed seeds among 55 small and marginal farmers of the affected areas. Nishkam member and the local representative S. Harvinder Singh along with the local associates and volunteers conducted the program and distributed seeds and fertilizers among the farmers.

In recent times the flood-affected families have been provided with dry rations, cooked food and medicines across various villages in Punjab in collaboration with the local associates. The delivery of aid and sustenance goods, including waterproof tents, linen sheets, clean drinking water, and dry eatables was underway. Under the banner of Nishkam, the council resolved to build/repair the houses damaged in such catastrophe to give them a chance to restart their lives with basic human survival.

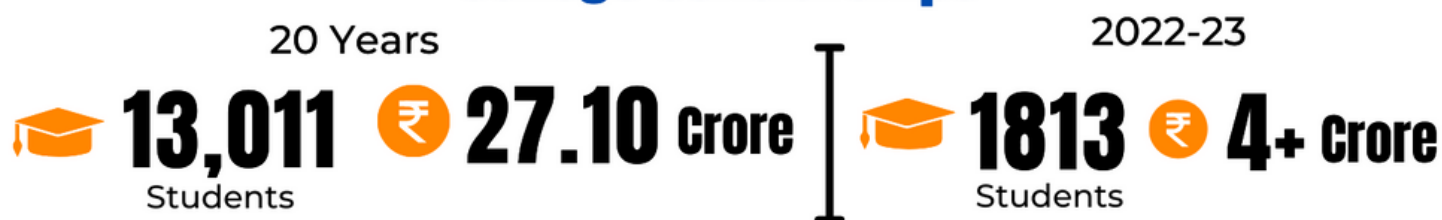
