Strengthening Linguistic Skills

In a commendable effort to enhance the linguistic abilities of children, volunteers at the Nishkam Sikh Welfare Association have initiated specialized English language classes. These classes commenced on April 28 and continue to make significant progress.

With a strong initial enrollment of over 60 students, the classes now see a dedicated group of about 40 students regularly attending. The sessions are held daily for two hours, six days a week, during the vacations ensuring consistent and comprehensive learning. The curriculum is designed to teach correct usage, spoken English, and comprehension skills through unseen passages.

Utilizing audio-visual presentations and innovative teaching methods, the program covers essential aspects of English such as grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and the use of idioms and proverbs. The balanced course content focuses on developing the students' speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills.

This initiative is a testament to the Association's commitment to fostering education and empowerment among children, equipping them with vital skills for their future.

Visits: Bridging the gap for Sikligar students

To review student beneficiaries from the Sikligar community, a team of Nishkam coordinators and members have been frequently visiting Uttar Pradesh and Haryana. They met school principals, teachers and parents as well. The schools shared the positive outcome of students who are regularly attending and performing well in academics and activities. More and more children from Sikligar families are going to school and excelling. The team also visited their Bastis (Hutments) and interacted with their parents.

In the initial years, it was quite challenging for Nishkam to build trust and facilitate the Sikligar community with education and welfare. The Sikligar families as a part of their traditional perception do not encourage young male folks to pursue education and girls are expected to marry at a very young age and follow the patriarchal norms where education is nowhere in their lives. But with consistent efforts, Nishkam found great success in pushing the community for the betterment. Now they feel empowered and educated and can live a dignified life with a better lifestyle and possibilities to earn more with the demanding socio-economical changes.

Husnpreet, an orphan in MGSN shine in the school exams



Husnpreet has cleared his annual Class 8th exam with 65 % marks. But unlike others, he has no one in the family to celebrate his success with. He lost both his parents when he was just 12 years old and has been living in MGSN since 2022. He lost his mother at a very early age, and his father brought him to MGSN but unfortunately, he lost his father too just a month back this year. With only his old grandmother left at home, he has been feeling a home at MGSN where he has been studying and living with smiles.
