Survival to Revival: Nishkam takes the lead in rebuilding flood-affected Punjab

The devastating destruction brought by the recent floods of the century in Punjab affected the lives of over 20 lakhs people, mostly farmers - our Annadatas - who lost their homes & livelihood and now face an uncertain future and unpredictable times ahead in all 23 districts of Punjab, impacting 2300+ villages.

About 5 lakh acres of lush, life-giving crops—wheat, rice, the fruit of months of back-breaking labour- were destroyed. 3200+ schools and 400+ Healthcare Centres were damaged. 8500 km of roads and 2500 bridges/culverts destroyed. Tens of thousands of homes -not just structures, but repositories of memories, of family, of safety-have been reduced to rubble and mud. The total accumulated losses in the 3 affected Districts of Punjab are thousands of crores, and the cost of rebuilding would be as high.

In keeping with the mission of selfless Sewa with a collaborative approach, Team Nishkam visited the flood-affected villages, specifically in the Malwa and Majha region, to support rebuilding and rehabilitation of flood-impacted brothers and sisters in Punjab. Nishkam distributed ration kits, medicines and cattle feed among the needy and helpless with the support of local partners and volunteers and has already identified scores of damaged houses for construction and renovation and allocated substantial funding for the purpose. In addition, Nishkam paid the discounted school fees amounting to Rs 1.77 lakhs to about 100 students to continue their studies uninterrupted.

Though the fields in Punjab are silent today. The homes of Punjabis are destroyed. The hope of lakhs of our Punjabi brothers is fading. But the indomitable spirit of Punjab and Punjabis cannot be broken by this natural tragedy and the floods. No doubt, the hands of our farmer brother who toil under the sun to fill our nation's granaries are bruised, and their resilience is being tested like never before, yet they are not despairing, and their strength and pride are intact. The reassuring part is that the legendary spirit of 'Chardi Kala' and the courage and faith of Punjab and Punjabis will surely restore the glory of the land of the 5 rivers, earlier than predicted by many.

We implore you, urge your compassion to stand with our brothers at this critical time. Let us offer them a helping hand. Let us come together to turn this tragedy into a testament of our collective compassion. Let us combine our efforts to help them rebuild not just houses, but homes—filled with hope once again.

In the quiet lanes of Samana a small town in Patiala, Punjab, where dreams often shrink to fit the confines of circumstance, a young boy named Gurpreet Singh dared to look up. His world was one of palpable hardship, where the rhythmic clinking of metal from his father's locksmith workshop—a traditional trade of the Sikligar community—was the soundtrack to a life of financial struggle. His admission to Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya was a pivotal turn, offering a quality education that became his sanctuary and his launch pad.

Here, his fascination with the intricacies of flight transformed into a focused ambition. He excelled academically, his grades a testament to a determination that refused to be dimmed. His teachers, recognising his extraordinary potential, became his first champions. It was through the guidance of his family and relatives that he learned of the Nishkam Scholarships, a program dedicated to empowering students from the Sikligar community. This was more than just financial aid; it was a validation of his dream, a message that his aspirations mattered.

Life transformed for Gurpreet when he was awarded the Nishkam scholarship, which effectively provided him with a launchpad to the Future. It was the key that unlocked the door to a prestigious college and a degree in aeronautical engineering. This support was not a handout; it was an investment, and Gurpreet was determined to yield an incredible return. He understood the weight of this opportunity—it was a chance to break a generational cycle of poverty and to honour the sacrifices of his parents.

University life presented a new set of challenges. The coursework was demanding, the environment unfamiliar. Yet, Gurpreet's resolve only strengthened. He became a master of balance, juggling rigorous academic schedules with part-time work. He taught at a local academy, sharing his knowledge to fund his dreams. In a remarkable display of versatility, he even lent his voice to the airwaves as a part-time Radio Jockey at Aakashwani Patiala, proving that his drive was as multifaceted as his talents. This period honed not just his engineering mind, but his character, instilling in him a resilience that would become his greatest asset.

Graduating with distinction was not the end of the journey, but the beginning. Gurpreet's first breakthrough came with an internship at Droneverse Aviation, a leading name in drone technology. Yet, adversity had one more test. Relocating to Gurgaon, he faced the stark reality of having no money for rent. Once again, the Nishkam Foundation stepped in, providing crucial support at a critical juncture. This act reinforced a vital lesson in Gurpreet's life: that success is rarely a solo flight—it is supported by a network of belief and encouragement.

Today, Gurpreet Singh is a Centre Manager for Drone Technology & Business Development at Advect Skills in Noida. He is no longer the boy looking up at the sky from a small town; he is now an architect of the technology that defines it. He is recognised for his innovative thinking and problem-solving skills, actively contributing to India's growing aerospace sector.

What makes Gurpreet's story truly inspiring is that his gaze remains grounded in gratitude. He remembers his roots and is passionately committed to giving back to the community that nurtured him. His journey is a testament to the transformative power of education, but also to the profound impact of targeted support systems like the Nishkam Scholarship. They do not just fund education; they fuel potential and unlock human capital that might otherwise remain untapped.

Gurpreet Singh's life is a powerful narrative that challenges the very notion of limitation. It reminds us that talent is universal, but opportunity is not. It proves that with unwavering determination, the support of a believing community, and an unyielding commitment to hard work, no dream is too high to reach. From the echoes of a locksmith's workshop to the cuttingedge of aerospace, his journey screams a truth we all need to hear: your beginnings do not define your horizons.
