


Pirtpal's upbringing was deeply connected to his small village life, where he was born to farmer parents who worked tirelessly on a modest piece of land. Though they had little material wealth, they were rich in love and hope. Pirtpal cherished the simplicity of village life, often assisting his family with cooking and farming, but he harbored aspirations that extended beyond the confines of seasonal cycles.

He completed his basic education at a local school and excelled academically, particularly in the non-medical stream. With dreams of enrolling at the prestigious NIT Rourkela for his engineering degree, he faced setbacks when he could not secure admission due to his JEE performance and financial constraints. Nevertheless, he gained access to education through support from the Bhai Jaitajee Foundation (BJF), which helped alleviate his financial burdens and guided him in applying for scholarships from Nishkam. Initially reliant on a loan from family friends, Pirtpal took control of his educational journey by successfully obtaining multiple scholarships.

His dedication was evident during his time at Punjab Engineering College in Chandigarh, where he committed numerous late nights to studying. He focused on enhancing his coding skills in areas such as algorithms, data structures, and software design. Pirtpal's hard work paid off when he secured a position at the Samsung Research Centre in Noida, where he thrived in an environment filled with intelligent peers and innovative technologies. This role not only provided him with exposure to real-world applications but also earned him recognition for his problem-solving aptitude and contributions.

Pirtpal's journey from a humble farming background to becoming a software engineer exemplifies the idea that no dream is unattainable with determination and perseverance. For him, the ultimate reward went beyond employment and financial compensation; it was the ability to uplift others. **He expressed his gratitude for the scholarships that were instrumental in his career by giving back to his community through Nishkam, actively supporting the growth and opportunities for others, just as he had experienced.**

Special Assembly Celebrates Guru Nanak Dev Ji's Birthday at Aligarh




