Despite these challenges, his parents instilled in him a strong sense of ambition and responsibility. Unlike his peers, Jaspreet nurtured a passion for learning, which helped him excel academically, especially in mathematics and science, during his time at a private school. This dedication earned him scholarships that funded his education from grades 7 to 12.

However, the likelihood of attending college remained uncertain due to his family's financial situation until he was accepted into Baba Banda Singh Bahadur Engineering College to pursue a B.Tech in Computer Science in 2007.

With limited support from his family and relying on an initial loan and help from relatives, Jaspreet discovered the SHDF scholarships from Nishkam in his second year. Receiving these scholarships significantly changed his life, allowing him to complete his degree and secure his first job at Infosys in 2011.

Jaspreet quickly advanced in the tech industry through his coding skills and innovative thinking, eventually working as a Software Developer at Upkarak Tech Solutions Pvt Ltd in Mohali.

His journey from a rural background to a successful career in IT shows how education and determination can overcome poverty. Despite his success, Jaspreet remains committed to his roots and gives back to Nishkam, embodying the principle of 'Sarbat Da Bhala' (Welfare of All).

His story is an inspiring reminder of the transformative power of education and resilience, demonstrating how one can change their life's path and serve as a beacon of hope for others.

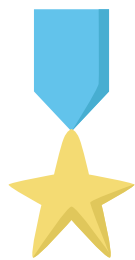

Gurneet, an 18-year-old, faced a life-changing challenge after the sudden death of his father from Tuberculosis, leaving him responsible for caring for his ill mother and managing household expenses. His life changed when his uncle introduced him to the Nishkam Computer Centre, where he gained essential digital skills, particularly in advanced Excel, during three months of training.

Seeking employment to ease financial burdens, Gurneet's teacher, S. Udeshpal Singh, helped him secure a job at REQ Serve, an IT firm near his home. Despite personal challenges, he persevered, supported his family, and continued his education through a distance learning program. Gurneet's story is one of resilience, gratitude for the support from the Nishkam Centre, and a commitment to building a better future for himself and his family.

In the village of Ramgarh, Baghpat, Uttar Pradesh, lives an 18-year-old boy named Vishal. His father, who also hails from Uttar Pradesh, belongs to the Sikligar community. No member of their family has ever attended college.

With sheer determination and support from Nishkam, an organization dedicated to serving the Sikligar community for over two decades across six states, Vishal Singh was assisted in gaining admission to the B. Pharmacy program at NGI College of Pharmacy, Meerut, U.P.

Parveen Singh, the father of Vishal, is the sole breadwinner of the family and has six children at home. He earns a meager income by selling and repairing locks and keys in a small shop in Ramgarh and sometimes works as a door-to-door vendor. Nishkam has been supporting all the children in their education for a long time. Vishal, the second child among his siblings, has received support from nursery to the present.

Vishal is blessed with brilliance and has performed very well academically, achieving good scores in his Intermediate Exams. The journey was difficult, but where there's a will, there's a way. He wanted to pursue a career in pharmacy, and today he has reached the college's doorstep; tomorrow, he will graduate as a professional.

Nishkam provides holistic, community-based empowerment, financial inclusion, education, and development by training, resourcing, and encouraging the Sikligar community to access and enjoy their basic human rights, which they have been deprived of for centuries, including education and social inclusion.
