

Nishkam Strengthens Flood Protection Efforts Along the Satluj River

Nishkam is committed to community welfare and is actively strengthening protective embankments along vulnerable stretches of the Satluj River in Punjab. This crucial initiative aims to safeguard villages, farmland, and thousands of residents from the recurring devastation of floods, particularly in regions like Ferozpur.

Nishkam has completed the first phase of an embankment in Dona Mattar village (Gajniwala area), fulfilling a long-standing community demand. This project became a priority after the 1988 floods caused significant damage across three districts. Following the severe impact of the August 2025 floods in Ferozpur, the council initiated construction with overwhelming local support.

Supervised by an expert civil engineer and built with the active involvement of resident volunteers, the project provides a robust defense against future flooding. By reinforcing these barriers, Nishkam is working to prevent disasters before they strike—offering long-term stability to vulnerable communities.
